The STD Code System

To make an STD call you dial a code followed by the called subscriber's number. The code for a trunk call is a series of letters and figures which identify the called exchange.

An STD code always starts with "0" to connect you to the trunk equipment.

There are five provincial cities where letters are already used for dialling local calls. For trunk calls to these cities, the first three figures of the code are Birmingham 021, Edinburgh 031, Glasgow 041, Liverpool 051 and Manchester 061. Thus for

Birmingham ACOcks Green 8000; dial 021 ACO 8000
and for Edinburgh WAVERley 1234; dial 031 WAV 1234

For other large towns the "0" is followed by two letters, generally the first two letters of the name and then a figure. Thus for

Nottingham 56789; dial 0NO 2 56789

and for Norwich 56789; dial 0NO 3 56789

The figure at the end of the code distinguishes between names which start with the same two letters or with letters having the same position on the dial. For smaller towns the code letters are sometimes taken from the name of a large town nearby, or the district, or county name and may be followed by up to three figures.

The exchanges you can dial, the codes to be used and the call charges are given in this booklet.

Subscriber Trunk Dialling Codes and Call Charges

WHAT TO DIAL

¶ For an exchange shown on the following pages, dial the code and then the number you want. For any other exchange, dial **100** for the operator.

WHAT IT COSTS

¶ Details of call charges are shown on page ii of cover opposite

When you make a call

First check the code and number

Lift the receiver and listen for dialling tone (a continuous purring)

Dial carefully and allow the dial to return freely

Then wait for another tone:

Ring tone (burr-burr) the number is being called

Engaged tone (slow pips) try again a few minutes later

Number unobtainable tone (steady note) replace receiver, re-check the code and number and then re-dial

After dialling a trunk call there will be a pause before you hear a tone; during this time the trunk equipment will be connecting your call

At the end of the call, replace the receiver securely because timing of calls stops when the caller hangs up

When you answer the telephone

Always give your name or telephone number

If you hear a series of rapid pips, the call is coming from a coin box telephone of the new type. Wait until the pips stop and then give your name or telephone number

How to get the best from STD

STD is quicker and cheaper, so dial as many of your calls as you can

Enter in your Personal Telephone Directory the names, dialling codes and numbers of people you call regularly; this will save you time in the future

When you dial, don't pause too long between digits.

Distinguish between the letter **I** and the figure **1**

If the number you want is engaged, try dialling again a few minutes later

Ask for the extension number on calls to a private exchange; this will save you time and money. If the extension you want is engaged it will usually pay, on an STD call, to clear and try again later

Remember, it costs only a few pence to dial a call to find out if the person you want is there; this is cheaper than paying for a personal call via the operator

If you hear a recorded announcement telling you that the trunk lines are engaged, replace the receiver and try again a few minutes later

Answer your telephone promptly, giving your name or telephone number. This saves time and money and helps the caller

Be sure your telephone arrangements are adequate. The Telephone Manager will always be pleased to give advice. Ask your enquiry operator (dial **INF**) if you require another copy of the Personal Directory or Dialling Code Booklet

CALL CHARGES

Nearly all trunk calls are cheaper if you dial them. For both local and dialled trunk calls you buy telephone time in twopennyworths, the amount of time bought for 2d. depending upon the distance of the call. When a dialled call is answered, your meter at the exchange registers once. This records one unit of time and each unit costs 2d. The meter registers again as each new time unit begins. There will be no time pips on dialled calls.

TRUNK CALLS CONNECTED BY THE OPERATOR

The call charges shown in the last two columns above apply to all trunk calls connected by the operator for any reason. The charge for each extra minute, beyond three minutes, is one-third of the rate shown.

Cheap rate periods

6 p.m. to 6 a.m. every night and all day Sunday.

The cheap rates may be suspended on certain days at Christmas and New Year.

Subscribers' meters

Subscribers' dialled trunk calls are recorded at the exchange on the same meters used for recording local calls. These meters are extremely reliable and are regularly tested. You can have a demonstration of how trunk and local calls

are recorded, if you care to visit the exchange. Dial **INF** to make an appointment.

Personal and transferred charge calls

With STD it costs only a few pence to dial a trunk call and ask for the person you want or to arrange for him to ring you back and this may be cheaper than the normal Personal or Transferred Charge Call services. You can, however, if you prefer, still obtain these services via the operator by dialling **100**.

Dialling to the Continent

WHEN IT STARTS

During the currency of this booklet facilities will become available for dialling direct to many places in France, Belgium, Germany, the Netherlands and Switzerland.

The introduction of these new services will be announced in the Press and you will receive advice about them from the Continental exchange operator when you are booking your calls.

WHAT TO DIAL

The chief exchanges to which you will be able to dial direct are listed below. You will dial the

code shown against the exchange and then the subscriber's number. For example for a call to Marseilles you dial **010 33 91** and then the subscriber's number. The tones you will hear are shown on page iii of cover.

If the place you want is not shown, dial **104** for Belgium, France and Switzerland or **105** for Germany and the Netherlands, and ask the operator. Please make a note of the code.

CONTINENTAL TONES

Ring tone in Continental countries is a medium pitched tone. Its speed varies from country to country but the bursts of tone are always evenly spaced with quite long pauses between them. It is unlike the British ringing tone.

Engaged tone in Continental countries is also medium pitched. Although its speed varies from country to country it is always much faster than ringing tone. In some countries it is rather similar to British engaged tone; in others, a little slower or very much faster.

Other special tones and recorded announcements are used in some Continental countries.

Calls connected by the operator

Should you want the operator to get your call dial **104** for Belgium, France and Switzerland or **105** for Germany and the Netherlands. The three minute minimum charge applies on all calls made through the operator.

NOTE: On the Continent telephone numbers are often written or quoted in various forms, such as (020)949999 or 020-949999. When dialling from this country you must ignore the figures in brackets or before the hyphen. For example, if an Amsterdam telephone number is quoted as (020)949999, you will see from the list that the code for Amsterdam is **010 31 20** and you will dial **010 31 20 949999**
